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1. INVITATION TO TENDER

3. SCOPE OF WORK / SUPPLY

The scope of work or supply shall broadly include procurement, supply, installation (where applicable), testing, commissioning, and/or provision of services as specified in **Annexure-A – Scope of Work / Technical Specifications**.

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5. BID SUBMISSION PROCESS

5.1 Bid Structure

5.2 Mode of Submission

5.5 Custody and Opening of Bid

- Physically submitted bids shall remain in **sealed custody of the Finance Team.**

5.6 Bid Validity

6. EARNEST MONEY DEPOSIT (EMD)

8. AWARD OF CONTRACT

Kinexin reserves the right to award the contract in full or in part or to split the order among multiple bidders, if deemed necessary.

9. COMMERCIAL TERMS & CONDITIONS

- **Price Basis**
 - Prices quoted shall be **firm and fixed** for the entire contract period.
 - Prices shall be quoted **exclusive of GST**, unless otherwise specified in the Price Bid.

10. DELIVERY / COMPLETION PERIOD

The delivery or completion period shall be as specified in **Annexure-A** and/or the Purchase Order.

11. LIQUIDATED DAMAGES

In the event of delay in delivery, completion, or failure to meet contractual obligations, Kinexin shall be entitled to levy liquidated damages at the rate specified in the Purchase Order or Contract, subject to the maximum limit specified therein. Levy of liquidated damages shall not absolve the bidder from completing the work.

12. TAXES & DUTIES

All applicable taxes, duties, and levies shall be borne and paid by the bidder unless otherwise specified in the contract.

13. CONFIDENTIALITY

All documents, data, and information provided by Kinexin shall be treated as confidential and shall not be disclosed without prior written consent, except as required by law.

14. TERMINATION

Kinexin may terminate the contract, in whole or in part, in case of material breach, failure to perform, insolvency, or for convenience by giving prior written notice. Upon termination, Kinexin may procure similar goods or services from alternate sources at the risk and cost of the bidder.

15. FORCE MAJEURE

Neither party shall be liable for failure to perform obligations due to events beyond reasonable control, including natural disasters, government actions, or other force majeure events, subject to timely notification.

16. INTEGRITY PACT & ANTI-BRIBERY

17. DISPUTE RESOLUTION

18. GOVERNING LAW & JURISDICTION
